The bins are a part of the Adopt A Block initiative, which was launched, by DSWMC, in collaboration with Discover Dominica Authority and Roseau City Council.

The Smart Litter Bin initiative has since reflected a cleaner city. To date, twenty-seven (27) businesses have adopted blocks in various parts of Roseau.
